Program Summary:

Clara's House is a safety net clinic providing comprehensive primary health care services to the uninsured in the greater Sacramento regional area. We serve the homeless, the undocumented, those for whom share of cost places health access beyond reach, those who are waiting to become eligible for county health care services, and those who are recently unemployed. The Breast Cancer Safety Net program provides screening mammograms, diagnostic mammograms with aspiration/biopsy as appropriate, breast health and screening awareness education, and community outreach to remove barriers to health care access and patient education. Often one of the barriers is cost. Clara's House provides these comprehensive health care services in a culturally sensitive context and at no cost to the patient, providing transportation to the clinic and imaging centers when needed. We partner with local agencies and churches, which have signed partnership agreements with the clinic, to fulfill some of the social net needs. Agency partners refer patients to the clinic and provide additional patient social services support creating a shared community commitment to health care for the uninsured in our area.
