**Program:** “Westside Breast Cancer Prevention Partnership”

**Program Summary:**

Center for Human Services, a non-profit agency serving youth and families in Stanislaus County, proposes continued & expanded services through our Westside Breast Cancer Prevention Partnership. The Partnership will provide culturally appropriate outreach, education, screening and diagnostic support to targeted women in rural Westside cities. There is no other resource for these services, given the barriers of geographic isolation, lack of access and poverty. Program goals are to increase awareness & attitudes regarding early detection & screening, provide increased access to mammograms in Westside communities, and provide 1:1 help to women in need of more medical care. The project will educate 600 women ages 14-50; assist 320 women to obtain mammograms & diagnostic care if needed, and create a network of breast care for women within the community. Services will be implemented through 3 Family Resource Centers by trained bilingual providers. Activities include outreach, educational presentations to high-school girls, community presentations to monolingual Spanish women ages 30-50, door-to-door outreach by Promotoras, referrals & screenings for mammograms, Peer Navigation help for all 320 women receiving screenings, and follow-up support and resources.
